

Welcome to Ironbound Elite tryouts for the 2021-2022 Season. We hope this helps you understand the process for Monday May 17, 2021.

Upon Entrance Everyone entering the facility will be:

- Required to wear a mask and masks must remain on throughout the duration of your stay (with one on-ice exception).
- Players will not be required to wear masks on the ice, but they must have masks on while entering, changing, and exiting the facility.
- Required to cooperate with daily COVID-19 screenings and temperature checks. (Parent or guardian must be present if the participant is under 18 years of age. Temperature must be 99.5 or lower).
- Required to sign a Release and Waiver of Liability (to be executed by parent or guardian if under 18) if they are new to the arena.

ATHLETES

The Locker rooms are closed, so players should arrive dressed with the exception of skates and helmets.

STEP 1: All players must check-in at the check-in table in the lobby to receive your tryout jersey and tryout jersey number.

Step 2: Head inside to the rink to finish dressing for tryouts. Older players (2006-2003) should change at the outside area to the left by Locker Rooms 1 & 2. Younger players (2007-2008) will change to the right outside of Locker Rooms 3 & 4.

Step 3: On-Ice Tryout

- 7:15-8:15pm years 2007 2008
- 8:45-10:00pm years 2003 2006

Step 4: After the coaches have finalized the teams, the rosters will be posted on the glass inside the rink.

Step 5: If you have been selected to play for an Ironbound team, the player and parent should go to the lobby to sign your player contract, player and parent code of conduct, consent to treat, and make the initial deposit for the season. Step 6: Players are then invited to the Ironbound Locker Room for further communication.

Step 7: Visit uniform vendor, Breakaway Hockey, to place your uniform order.

- Everyone must wear a mask when sizing, one girl at a time.
- There is a list of required items per team on the site.

PARENTS

Step 1: Please prepare your daughter that tryouts are meant to place players on a team where coaches believe they will have the best experience and develop the most.

Step 2: Parents are allowed inside the rink during the on-ice tryout. Please maintain proper social distance (at least 6 feet) from others throughout the facility.

Step 3: If your daughter has been selected for an Ironbound team you will need to sign a contract and put a 50% deposit down to secure your daughter's spot on the team. We accept checks, cash and credit cards. There will be a credit card processing fee if you choose to pay via credit card. The balance will be due on August 15th.
